Keyword Search

Search retrieves over 25 items--including books and magazines.

Search: General Keyword [utah* and snowboard*]

Provides **description, location, & availability** about items owned by and accessible at the Marriott, Quinney Law, and Math Libraries. Catalog also finds journals, newspapers, videos, CDs, DVDs, maps, manuscripts, and government documents.

If you know either author or title, try **Authors** or **Titles** searches:

Search: Author Exact [rowling j] Last name beginning letters in first name

Search: All Title Exact [lord of the rings]



To find materials from the Eccles Health Sciences Library, use their Library Catalog <http://155.100.78.49:916/ipac20/ipac.jsp?&profile=ec#focus>. The Eccles Library has the largest collection of medical journals in the intermountain west.

Finding Journals and Newspapers

1. Click icon **Journal/Newspaper**
2. Omit beginning articles: A, An, or The New York Times not The New York Times
3. Search: **Journal/Newspaper Title Exact** [journal of sport]

Finding Online Journals

1. Go to www.lib.utah.edu
2. Click on link Online Journals <http://atoz.ebsco.com/home.asp?Id=dvuou>
3. Either search by first letter of journal title or type in journal title in Find box

PEER REVIEW: Process of accepting papers in scholarly journals, in which researchers who are experts in the field covered by the work in question decide whether an article is a reliable and quality addition to the conversation in the field. Examples: *Journal of Leisure Research*, *Journal of Organic Chemistry*, *Sport Psychologist*, *Shakespeare Bulletin*, etc.

Understanding a Library Catalog Record

Describes, in general, the “outside” of items.:

Journals, Magazines, and Newspapers

- Title, publisher, publication dates, subjects, electronic location (if available), size, library location, call number, and volumes/issues the library owns.
 - Author names of articles and article titles are not included.

Books, CDs, DVDs, Maps, Government Documents, etc.

- Title, author(s), publisher, publication dates, subjects, electronic location (if available), number of pages, size, library location, and call number.
- Provides information to cite work in Bibliography or Works Cited page.

Periodicals

Identifies this item as a **serial**: magazine or journal or newspaper.

Current Issues

Newest issues of a journal are shelved individually. Look at “Notes” to see which level.

Bound Volumes

Older issues are bound together & shelved with other books. Look at “Collection” to see which level.

Both current issues and bound volumes use same call number.
